- * integral part of the PARIS 2024 qualification structure

 (IOC Urban Series and QS pending IOC EB Decision 02/2022)
- * highest Level of Ranking Events similar to the WDSF GS in Standard/Latin

WDSF WORLD BREAKING CHAMPIONSHIP plus up to 5 more events in different countries – 4 or 5 events leading into a final event by the end of the year

Maximum one event per year/country

Maximum participation of 3 B-Boys/3 B-Girls per NMB (World Championship 2 B-Boys / 2 B-Girls) nominated by NMB

Use of TRIVIUM Judging System or WDSF recognized equivalent judging System mandatory

Prize money (minimum advised by WDSF) – paid by Organizer

Highest status regarding ranking points

7/9 Judges from 7/9 countries nominated by WDSF

1 Headjudge nominated by WDSF

1 Competition Chair nominated by WDSF

Silver Color Logo / Graphic Element

Maximum three events per country/calendar year

No limits regarding maximum participation per NMB

Use of THREE FOLD judging system or WDSF recognized equivalent judging system mandatory / TRIVIUM may be used by WDSF approval

Prize Money (WDSF advice of maximum – paid by Organizer) – maximum prize money should not exceed the minimum given for WDSF BREAKING FOR GOLD WORLD TOUR

7 Judges from 7 countries - nominated by WDSF

1 Headjudge - nominated by WDSF

1 Competition Chair - nominated by WDSF

Basic Level Ranking Events

- * NMB's encouraged to establish a National Ranking List > Top 3 qualified for WDSF Breaking for Gold World Tour
- * low fee, least restrictions -> easy start for NMB's

Bronze Color Logo / Graphic Element

All NMB's shall be encouraged to organize these as a start and use this category to establish a national ranking list No limited number of events/year

no limits regarding participation per NMB

Events may be held as National events or as International events

Use of THREE FOLD judging system or WDSF recognized equivalent judging system mandatory

5 Judges from 5 countries - nominated by NMB / approved by WDSF

1 Headjudge - nominated by NMB / approved by WDSF

1 Competition Chair - nominated by NMB / approved by WDSF

Competition procedure to be proposed by NMB – must be approved by WDSF
